





2003 – 2010 Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP)




Twin Lakes Elementary School (TLE):

- TLE has increased its Students with Disabilities by +38 percentage points in its Percent of Students Scoring At/Above Proficiency in Math from 2003 to 2010!
- In 2003, TLE's Students with Disabilities subgroup was above (+14 percentage points) the State (SWD) Subgroup in Percent of Students Scoring At/Above Proficiency in Math. During the seven-year ACALETICS® partnership, TLE increased the achievement gap above the State to +32 percentage points ("A Gap Expansion") in 2010!



AMELIA EARHART ELEMENTARY SCHOOL (AEE)

2003 – 2007 Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP)




Amelia Earhart Elementary School (AEE):

- AEE increased its Students with Disabilities by +35 percentage points in its Percent of Students Scoring At/Above Proficiency in Math from 2003 to 2007!
- In 2003, AEE's Students with Disabilities subgroup was above (+3 percentage points) the State (SWD) Subgroup in Percent of Students Scoring At/Above Proficiency in Math. During the fouryear ACALETICS® partnership, AEE increased the achievement gap above the State to +24 percentage points ("A Gap Expansion") in 2007!



NORTH ELEMENTARY SCHOOL (NRE) 2006 – 2007 Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP)




North Elementary School (NRE):

- NRE increased its Students with Disabilities by +28 percentage points in its Percent of Students Scoring At/Above Proficiency in Math from 2006 to 2007!
- In 2006, NRE's Students with Disabilities subgroup was below(-8 percentage points) the State (SWD) Subgroup in Percent of Students Scoring At/Above Proficiency in Math. As a result of our partnership, NRE exceeded the achievement of the State by +18 percentage points ("A Gap Reversal") in 2007!



EAST MARION ELEMENTARY SCHOOL (EME)

2006 – 2010 Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP)



East Marion Elementary School (EME):

- EME has increased its Students with Disabilities subgroup Percent Scoring At/Above Proficiency by +41 percentage points from 2006 to 2010!
- In 2006, EME's Students with Disabilities subgroup was significantly below (-28 percentage points) its White Subgroup in Percent of Students Scoring At/Above Proficiency in Math. During the four-year ACALETICS® partnership, EME closed the achievement gap by +17 percentage points in 2010!. Note, with our partnership the White subgroup also showed tremendous progress from 53% to 77%.
